The popular Ford Galaxie line competed directly with the Chevrolet Impala which reigned supreme as the king of 1960s family cars. The Galaxie first appeared in 1959 as a model on the full size Ford Fairlane lineup. In 1962 the Fairlane name dropped down to the intermediate bodies and Galaxie became the name of all the full size Fords.

This ALLEY FINDS 1962 Galaxie was for sale in 2014 for \$999.00 but didn't find any buyers. The engine was running well prior to being junked. Its now missing its carburetor and most of the interior. The hood is sitting on the roof. Its sad to see this once proud car finally going down for the count after surviving for 52 years.



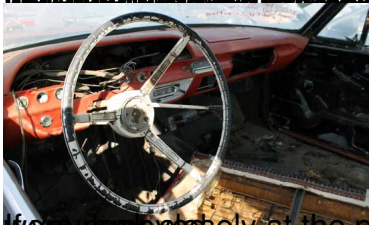
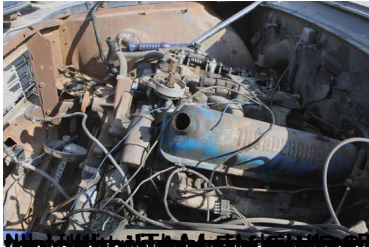
