This 1967 Chrysler 300 sports weathered Scorch Red paint and a pretty rough interior due to the wind having whipped away the last wisps of the convertible top allowing the weather to work its wonders. This 300 is part of the Charles Kee collection which was auctioned off in May, 2014 following Kee's death in 2013. Most of the Kee cars were collected in the 1980s on a 50 acre property in Brothers, Oregon for storage outside in the desert.

Whoever first ordered this car was serious about high performance driving and comfort. The car is loaded with musclecar goodies and creature comforts.
